Recovery Court Eligibility Criteria

- Offender must be charged within Hamilton County, Tennessee.
- Offender must be between 13-17 years of age.
- The current charge must be a non-violent, drug, or property-related felony or misdemeanor.
- Offender cannot have habitual motor vehicle violations.
- Offender cannot have any outstanding charges or hold any charges in outer counties.
- Offender cannot have current sex offender charges or be a sex offender.
- Offender must be a resident of Hamilton County.
- Offender cannot be acutely mentally ill or suicidal.
- Offender cannot have significant history of drug trafficking.

NOTE: This recommendation can be made as mandatory probation condition. The Magistrate may inquire as to specifics of violation if re-docketed.

Youth Court Eligibility Criteria

- TCA 37-1-702 (c)(1): <u>Diversion</u> for minors adjudicated as delinquent or unruly.
 Also, as a disposition after Judicial Diversion
- Examples: Truancy or Unruly, Assault, Burglary, Theft of property, Vandalism,
 Forgery, Cruelty to animals, Unauthorized use of a vehicle, Criminal Attempt,
 Disorderly Conduct, Harassment, Criminal Trespass, Traffic Offenses, Runaway

NOTES:

- Cannot be recommended simultaneously with probation
- Proceeding shall be suspended for 6 months or other time authorized by local rules
- There cannot be special circumstances such as mental illness, developmental disability, or special needs of a victim.
