A RESOLUTION PROCLAIMING JULY 16th AS A “DAY OF REMEMBRANCE” IN HAMILTON COUNTY, TENNESSEE, BY HONORING THE LIVES OF UNITED STATES ARMED FORCES MEMBERS SLAIN IN HAMILTON COUNTY ON SAID DATE.

WHEREAS, on Thursday, July 16th, 2015, five United States Armed Forces Service Members were slain in Chattanooga, Hamilton County, Tennessee, as a result of a senseless act of violence; and

WHEREAS, the five slain United States Armed Forces Members were United States Navy Petty Officer Randall Smith and United States Marine Service Members Lance Corporal Squire “Skip” Wells, Gunnery Sergeant Thomas Sullivan, Sergeant Carson Holmquist and Staff Sergeant David Wyatt; and

WHEREAS, Hamilton County wishes to proclaim July 16th of each year as a “Day of Remembrance” to honor the dedicated service and ultimate sacrifice of the five Military Service Members who were slain on said date.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, BY THIS COUNTY LEGISLATIVE BODY IN SESSION ASSEMBLED:

That July 16th of each year hereafter is hereby proclaimed as a “Day of Remembrance” in honor of the dedicated service and ultimate sacrifice of the five Service Members who were slain in Hamilton County on said date.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT THIS RESOLUTION TAKE EFFECT FROM AND AFTER ITS PASSAGE, THE PUBLIC WELFARE REQUIRING IT.
