COMMITTEE ASSIGNMENTS

Commissioner McClure provided additional details regarding this Resolution. He reported that he had attended a public meeting in Bledsoe County recently to discuss the potential closure. He noted that the format for this Resolution had been crafted by Juvenile Court Judge Suzanne Bailey and himself, with input by Attorney Taylor. He informed the Commission that Judge Bailey was very supportive of the efforts at the Taft Youth Center and desired to see its continued operation.

Commissioner McClure pointed out that the resolving paragraph of Resolution No. 112-17 requested that the State consider not terminating the center's operations, or as an alternative, giving consideration to the development of a new youth center in southeast Tennessee.

Commissioner Graham, noted that Resolution No. 112-16 was currently assigned to the Finance Committee. He questioned whether this Resolution should be heard by the Delinquent Tax Property Special Committee that he chaired. Chairman Henry asked that this Resolution be re-assigned to the Delinquent Tax Property Special Committee.
