CHILD SUPPORT PAYMENT PROCESSING
CHANGES EFFECTIVE 10-01-99

Soon there will be a significant change in the way child support payments are processed. The change is mandated by the Personal Responsibility and Work Opportunity Reconciliation Act of 1996 (Public Law 104-93, Section 454B), which requires states to establish and operate a Centralized Disbursement Unit for child support payments. This change will require all payments on Title IV-D cases and payments paid through income withholding on some Non IV-D cases to be sent to the Centralized Disbursement Unit In Nashville, Tennessee. In an effort to increase awareness and understanding of Centralized Collections, the State of Tennessee will soon be sending notices to those that will be affected by the change.
