Now, as a GMA Dove Award®-winning producer (Confio/Jaci Velasquez) and creative partner in The Creak Music (Brandon Lake, Cody Carnes, NEEDTOBREATHE, Ben & Noelle Kilgore, and more), he's also racked up stellar songwriting credits such as "Great Are You Lord," "Christ Be All Around," and "All The Poor and Powerless." It was in 2019 when he released his first solo project, *The Wait*, a special collection of personal and reflective songs.
