"Average Daily Cost" to House Prisoners as of 6/30

The attached schedule was updated as of June 30, 2022, and shows five years of cost data for housing prisoners in Hamilton County, Tennessee. As shown, the "Average Daily Cost" <u>decreased</u> approximately \$10,000 per day (from \$86,739 at fiscal year ended 6/30/21 to \$76,830 at fiscal year ended 6/30/22). This was primarily due to the termination of the CORE Civic contract on 12/30/2020, along with housing less federal prisoners due to the capacity limit of 1,084 for one facility.
