

THE PUBLIC'S OPPORTUNITY TO ADDRESS THE COUNTY COMMISSION

Any citizen, resident, or other interested person shall be afforded the privilege of addressing the Commission prior to the adjournment of each meeting on any matter other than zoning which is not on the Agenda for the upcoming meeting. Permission to address the Commission shall be acquired by notifying the Commission Office and/or staff (by email, mail, or phone call) of the desire to do so at least one (1) week prior to the meeting in which they desire to speak. Said notice shall include the speaker's name, address, and subject to which the Commission is to be addressed. It shall be the exclusive decision of the Chairman (subject to appeal from said decision by the entire Commission) as to whether permission will be granted to the requestor to speak before the Commission. Those granted permission to speak to the Commission shall be afforded three (3) minutes to make their respective presentation.

No presenter/speaker addressing the Commission shall be allowed to levy any verbal attacks, or single out, any member of the Commission, County Official, or any County employee.
