

TITLE VI



Hamilton County Government Assures Nondiscrimination in All Programs and Activities Receiving Federal Financial Assistance

Among other things, in operating a federally assisted program, a recipient cannot, on the basis of race, color, or national origin, either directly or through contractual means:

- Deny program services, aids, or benefits;
- Provide a different service, aid or benefit, or provide them in a manner different than they are provided to others;
- Segregate or separately treat individuals in any matter related to the receipt of any service, aid, or benefit; or
- Fail to take reasonable steps to provide Limited English Proficiency (LEP) persons with meaningful access to programs and activities.

If you believe that you or others protected by Title VI have been discriminated against, you may file a complaint with the Hamilton County Title VI Department.
